He has acted on some of the most complex consumer mass claims of the last decade and is particularly focused on coordinating the defence of such litigation across borders. He has a particular specialism in product liability defence work, and is rated in Band 1 for Life Sciences: Product Liability by Chambers.

Andrew advises clients on the application of product liability rules to emerging tech, and in May 2018 was appointed to the European Commission's Expert Group on Liability and New Technologies. In December 2019, he joined the Commission's subgroup on AI and product safety. Another area of focus, in recent years, has been the growing importance of consumer law and governments' increasing scrutiny of consumer-facing business practices.

Andrew is Co-Head of the firm's Consumer and Healthcare group, which brings together specialists in the consumer, retail and life sciences sectors from across the firm. He also helps lead Halo, the firm's global LGBT+ network group.
